JS 17-01 *Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa' – This hybrid yielded large reds, blues, and pinks that usually peloric and of good flower size. Many had spots.
JS 17-02 *Sinningia speciosa* 'Sentsational Pepperpot' x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa' – In this cross *S. 'Pedra Lisa'* proved dominant. I got many combinations of lavender and white nodding flowers, some with 6 petals and some were pleasantly fragrant.
JS 17-03 *S. 'Rock Royalty'* x (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Sentsational Pepperpot' x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Thad's Gas Planet') – I got many clear red and dark purple flowers that had shallow throats and wide corollas and lighter throats. Incidentally, *S. 'Rock Royalty'* is a cross of (SPP x SPL). It is very dark purple with wavy petals.
JS 17-04 *Sinningia speciosa* 'Rock Presence' (a 6 lobed lavender) x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' – I am hoping for good sized red nodding flowers with fragrance.
JS 17-05 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') x (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') – This is a sibling cross between a large white and a soft lavender seedling. They both had nodding flowers of good size and were slightly fragrant.
JS 17-06 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') x (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' x *Sinningia speciosa* 'Thad's Gas Planet') – This was a cross between a dark red and a 6 lobed blue flower. Hoping for a floriferous plant with red nodding flowers of good size.

JS 17-07 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Thad's Gas Planet') × (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') — A light nodding lavender crossed onto a dark peloric red.

JS 17-08 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Sentsational Pepperpot' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') × (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') — I got a very compact seedling with great veining in the foliage and crossed it onto a large nodding white flower. I'm hoping for large white flowers on a compact plant with great foliage.

JS 17-09 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Sentsational Pepperpot' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') × (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Thad's Gas Planet') — I made this cross hoping for 6 lobed red nodding flowers with fragrance. The pollen parent was a large dark red crossed onto a 6 lobed lavender nodding flower.

JS 17-10 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Thad's Gas Planet') × (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') — This cross has a large white nodding flower crossed onto a peloric red. I was hoping for red flowers with white on the outside.

JS 17-11 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Sentsational Pepperpot' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') × (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Sentsational Pepperpot' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Thad's Gas Planet') — A peloric red onto a blue nodding flower that had a strong scent. I was hoping for a fragrant red.

JS 17-12 *Sinningia speciosa* 'Sentsational Pepperpot' × (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Thad's Gas Planet' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') — This cross is the batch of seed that 'Rock Loves Dale' came from.

JS 17-13 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Bristol's Good Morning' × *Sinningia speciosa* 'Pedra Lisa') × Peloric White — I bought a commercially produced peloric white *S. speciosa* and crossed it onto a good red, hoping for some combination of red and white.

JS 17-14 (*Sinningia speciosa* 'Hungarian Rose Spot' × *Sinningia* 'Dales Coral Fiesta') × self — Yes, Dales Coral Fiesta, a miniature sinningia crossed onto a *S. speciosa* from an unknown Hungarian seed source. This seed is untried and spontaneously generated a seed pod with no help from me. I expect various shades of pink and coral petals with blue spots. Most of the flowers will have white throats.
