


Terri Vicenzi has light stands in numerous rooms throughout her house in Bloomington, Indiana. Here she is holding her cat, Blue.

Streptocarpus plants growing in the lower level of her house.






A large wooden bar top serves as a convenient work area for various plant related chores.

Terri uses clear packing tape to tape pots to her reservoirs so that the plants do not tip over when the streptocarpus leaves grow large.











